Three Suspects Arrested In Overnight Homicide

Interim Chief Norman Caldwell has announced the arrests of three suspects in last night's homicide at 901 Colleton Street (Gable Oaks Apartments).

Columbia Police have arrested Marcus Isaiah Farr: B/M/19, Sherman Roger Farr: B/M/21 and Mertis Rashad Bradshaw: B/M/19 and have been charged with murder of Charles McDaniel 19 of Columbia. At this time Marcus Farr has confessed to the shooting of the two victims during the incident last night and Sherman Farr and Bradshaw have corroborated Marcus Farr's confession. Marcus Farr, Sherman Farr and Bradshaw are still being questioned by Investigators and they will be transferred to Alvin S. Glenn Detention Center after further questioning.

The second victim, Maurice Boykin 22 of Columbia was transported to Richland Memorial Hospital and last reported he was in critical but stable condition.

Marcus Farr, Sherman Farr and Bradshaw were accompanied by a family member to Police Headquarters @ 2:00 p.m. today when they turned themselves in.

Chief Caldwell and the Columbia Police Department would like to thank the Richland County Sheriff's Department and the South Carolina Law Enforcement Division for the assistance in the apprehension of these suspects.
