Columbia Police Searching for Suspect

The City of Columbia Police Department is looking for a suspect that committed an armed robbery at the South Carolina Federal Credit Union at 1405 North Millwood Ave on June 12, 2008 @ 5:12 PM.

The suspect is described as a 19-21 year old black male, @ 5'11" and 160 lbs. At the time of the armed robbery he was wearing a dark colored long-sleeved shirt over a white shirt, black/white sneakers, and white hat with NY on the front, blue jeans and a brown bandana across his face. The suspect used a large revolver and pointed it at a teller and demanded money. The suspect fled on foot with an undisclosed amount of money and was traveling north on North Millwood Ave.
